

UN-DIGI-CONTEST

1. General statements

UN-DIGI-CONTEST is organized and held by the national amateur radio society The Kazakhstan Federation of Radiosport and Radioamateur (KFRR).

2. Participants

Licensed radio amateurs and club stations and SWLs from Kazakhstan and all over the world

3. Contest period, bands and modes

Contest period: December 15, 2017, 14.00 - 17.59 UTC.

Bands: 160m, 80m, 40m

Modes: RTTY, BPSK63.

4. Entry categories

SO-AB-MIX - Single operator, all bands, all modes

MO-AB-MIX – Multi op, all bands, all modes

SWL - Short Wave Listeners, all bands

5. Terms of Competition

5.1 The contest is splitted into two rounds, two hours each:

1st round 14.00 - 15.59 (UTC).

2nd round 16.00 - 17.59 (UTC).

5.2 Runtime for all the participants - 4 hours

5.3 Contest call is “CQ UN TEST”.

5.4 Control number consists of RST and QSO serial number, like 599001.

5.5 Recommended frequency bands: 1838-1843 , 3580-3600 , 7040-7050 KHz.

5.6 Only one signal can be transmitted at any time.

5.7 Using DX-cluster networks is permitted.

5.8 Self-spotting is forbidden.

5.9 Dupes are contacts made with the same station on the same band and the same mode in the same round. Dupes are allowed, but they do not give any points. Anyway, deleting dupes from the contest report is not recommended.

6. Contact points and Multipliers

6.1 Each complete QSO - 2 points

6.2 The multiplier is the number of different callsign prefixes. Multipliers are different for different bands and rounds.

6.3 For SWLs an one-way observation (received both callsigns but only one control numver) gives 1 point and a two-way observation (both callsigns and both control numbers) gives three points. The number of observations of the same station should be not more than 3 per round (in the same mode).

7. Final Score

The final score is a total contact points number multiplied by the total amount of multipliers.

8. Jury

In the case when two participants get the same score, the jury is able to award two (not more) participants as winners in an entry category.

9. Submission of Logs

Logs in Cabrillo format should be submitted in 15 days from the end of the contest to the email: un-digi-c@mail.ru .

Log should be sent as an email attachment. The subject line of an E-mail with your log must contain your callsign and category

10. Awards

Participants from Kazakhstan, who took 1-3 places are awarded with diplomas, participants from other countries are awarded with electronically issued diplomas (for 1-3 places too).

Additional awards are possible.
